- WARNING-

Under the Connecticut Equine Activity Liability Act, each person engaged in recreational equestrian activities shall assume the risk and legal responsibility for any injury to his person or property arising out of the hazards inherent in equestrian sports, unless the injury was proximately caused by the negligence of the person providing the horse or horses to the individual engaged in recreational equestrian activities or the failure to guard or warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity by the person providing the horse or horses or his agents or employees.

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, association rules, if applicable, or Management in all other cases, shall settle any dispute or question that may arise and its decision shall be final. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition or entries, and cancel or combine classes, or to reschedule classes, to change rings or rotate judges; and to change specifications in jumper classes. Management may designate a jumping order, use THE ONE MINUTE RULE, and/or use a "dotted line"

ENTRIES

- 1) No horse may participate in the event or be on the grounds without having a completed entry blank, including signatures acknowledging the agreement printed thereon.
- 2) Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents, even though payment may not be submitted along with the entry. Fees owed from previous shows may be added to this or future show accounts.
- 3) CLOSING DATE is stated on officials' page and entry blank. NO STALL RESERVATIONS ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT prior to closing date. ENTRIES received after closing date incur an additional fee of \$35 per horse. Management reserves the right to limit post entries. Refunds for entries are given with cancellation prior to show less a \$35 processing fee; **NO REFUND FOR STALL FEES.**
- 4) RETURNED CHECKS will be assessed \$25.00 for each re-deposit and \$50 if check cannot be presented through a bank as a cash item.
- 5) NUMBERS are issued only with completed entry blank and an open check in the office.
- 6) ADDITIONAL FEES may be incurred including: Non-stabling fee \$40 (for entries not requiring a stall). Office Fee \$40. Non-showing Fee \$50.
- 7) NON SHOWING HORSES must complete an entry blank and be assigned a number.

CHJA STATEMENT: Every class offered herein which is recognized by CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA Rules. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders **MUST** be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards. the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications and membership applications are available at the show office and at www.chja.net.

MEASUREMENT: Entries must possess a valid USEF card or be measured before showing.

DISCOURTESY: to an official by any owner, rider, trainer, or groom will

disqualify any horses with which they are associated and fees for horses forfeited.

PRIZE MONEY: paid at conclusion of show or credited to account. Checks must be cashed within 60 days. A rated hunter classes offering \$100 in prize money pay as follows: \$40, 25, 20,15; All other hunter and jumper classes pay out designated prize money as follows: 30%,22%, 15%, 13%, 10%, 10% - All hunter classics pay out designated prize money as follows: 30%,22%,15%,10%,7%,6%,5%,5%

- jumper classics/stakes pay out 25%, 15%,13%, 12%, 10%,9%,8%,8%.

CHAMPION AND RESERVE: awarded in accordance with USEF rules; all performance classes in a section have full points court toward championship, model classes to get half-points. Trophy and ribbons to eight places awarded in all classes.

HUNTER CLASSES: judged on performance, soundness, manners. Suitability of animal and rider will be emphasized with extreme speed penalized. Classes pinned to eight places. **FENCES:** As in USEF HU-3.

UNDER SADDLE: classes except Green and Short Stirrup, may walk, trot, canter and gallop.

SHAVINGS AND HAY: orders must be made by 12:00 noon. No deliveries on Saturday or Sunday. No feed available on the show grounds. **NO OUTSIDE DELIVERIES ALLOWED WITHOUT PRIOR ARRANGEMENT WITH MANAGEMENT.**

STALLS: LIMITED STABLING available on a first come, first served basis. 10x10 canvas w/ doors available the day before show. ONE STALL PER ANIMAL. **NO SHARING OF STALLS;** An exhibitor who wants to arrive early or leave late must communicate and confirm arrangements.

SCHOOLING: as determined by management and in designated areas only. A Medic is on duty during scheduled classes.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Containers are located throughout the barn area. Please dispose of needles properly.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All exhibitors are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while jumping. Junior exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets whenever mounted. It is the responsibility of the rider, the parent/guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to ensure that the head gear worn complies with appropriate safety standards, is properly fitted, and in good condition.

DOGS: Must be leashed and under control or \$50 will be assessed the Owner and dog may be impounded.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES Operated by licensed drivers. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are

accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause of sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and /or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devised for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

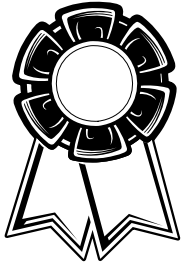
