Chateau Elan Resort is located 30 minutes north of Atlanta, off I-85 at Exit 126. From the South, turn left off of the exit onto Hwy. 211 and cross over the interstate. From the North, turn right onto Hwy. 211. The Equestrian Center, Winery, Inn and Spa are the first gate on the left. After entering the property, take the first left just a short way past the entrance gate; the horse show grounds will be on your right after the large curve.

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION SPECIFICATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, association rules, if applicable, or Management in all other cases, shall settle any dispute or question that may arise and its decision shall be final. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition or entries, and cancel or combine classes, or to reschedule classes, to change rings or rotate judges; and to change specifications in jumper classes. Management may designate a jumping order, use THE ONE MINUTE RULE, and/or use a "dotted line".

ENTRIES

1) No horse may participate in the event or be on the grounds without having a completed entry blank, including signatures acknowledging the agreement printed thereon.

2) Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents, even though payment may not be submitted along with the entry. Fees owed from previous shows may be added to this or future show accounts.

3) CLOSING DATE is stated on officials' page and entry blank. STALL RESERVATIONS **with check** prior to closing date receive a discounted stall price. ENTRIES received after closing date incur an additional fee of \$30 per horse. Refunds for entries are given with cancellation prior to show less a \$30 processing fee; no refund for stall fees paid if temporaries are erected. Classes entered and not scratched before class commences will be charged to the exhibitor.

4) RETURNED CHECKS will be assessed \$25.00 for each re-deposit and \$50 if check cannot be presented through a bank as a cash item.

5) NUMBERS are issued only with completed entry blank and an open check in the office.

6) ADDITIONAL FEES may be incurred including: Grounds fee \$40 (for entries not requiring a stall). Office Fee \$35.

7) MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold the Management, Staff, and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor's entry will be accepted unless it is signed by a parent or guardian.

PRIZE MONEY: paid at conclusion of show or credited to fees owed. Checks must be cashed within 60 days.

MEASUREMENT: Entries must present a valid USEF card or be measured before showing. **Pony/horse measurement is scheduled for Friday at 4:00pm.**

DISCOURTESY: to an official by any owner, rider, trainer, or groom will disqualify any horses with which they are associated and fees for horses forfeited.

CHAMPION AND RESERVE: awarded in accordance with USEF rules; all performance classes in a section have full points court toward championship.

model classes to get half-points.

HUNTER CLASSES: judged on performance, soundness, manners. Suitability of animal and rider will be emphasized with extreme speed penalized. Classes pinned to eight places. **FENCES:** As in USEF HU 12 and HP 107. **UNDER SADDLE:** classes except Green and Short Stirrup, may walk, trot, canter and gallop. Last class number of each section is under saddle. Ribbons to eight places awarded in all hunter and equitation classes.

FEED AND BEDDING: orders must be made by 12:00 noon. NO OUTSIDE DELIVERIES ARE ALLOWED.

RV/CAMPER SPACES: Water & electric hookups available. \$120/show. Camper fee assessed per show; includes trailers with living quarters which are connected to any electric or water service on show grounds. **CAMPERS MUST BE IN DESIGNATED AREAS.**

STALLS: 10x10 permanent w/ doors available the day before show; temporary stalls may be assigned if entries warrant. **ONE STALL PER ANIMAL.** NO SHARING OF STALLS; early arrival requires prior communication with show management. An exhibitor who wants to arrive early or leave last must contact management BEFORE the competition by answered telephone or confirmed e-mail to make arrangements.

SCHOOLING: in designated areas only. **HELMETS MUST BE WORN WHENEVER MOUNTED.** A Medic is on duty only when scheduled classes are performing. Starters have authority to scratch riders who do not follow directions. Schooling is permitted in hunter rings the day before competition subject to management's discretion. Paid warm-up MAY be available after scheduled classes on show days at managements discretion and based on ring quality and time considerations. Flat work is available in all rings all days up to one hour prior to commencement of scheduled classes; management may designate a ring closed if conditions warrant.

DOGS: Must be leashed and under control or \$30 will be assessed the Owner and dog may be impounded.

COGGINS TESTS: Negative certificates dated within 1 year are required for admittance to the grounds.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES Operated by licensed drivers. Persons who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause of sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and /or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devised for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
